2026 NNOG Conference May 12-15, 2026 Glendale, Arizona

Dear Colleague:

Salt River Project (SRP) and Old Dominion Electric Cooperative (ODEC) are hosting the 2026 Nuclear Nonoperating Owners Group (NNOG) conference from May 12-15, 2026, at the Renaissance Phoenix Glendale Hotel & Conference Center in Glendale, Arizona.

The NNOG conference provides opportunities to learn about the commercial nuclear industry and the challenges facing non-operating owners. The conference will cover an overview of nuclear industry issues and, after the conference, attendees will have current information on technical and business issues facing non-operating owners of nuclear plants with material that is suitable for those with all levels of industry knowledge. Conference participants will gain an understanding of various topics that are useful in owner oversight and management of nuclear assets. There are no prerequisites or advanced preparation necessary to attend the NNOG conference.

This year's conference features two days of first-class presentations, discussions and a reception on Wednesday evening to promote networking among nuclear colleagues. As with past conferences, a pre-conference tour is planned for Tuesday, May 12, 2026. This tour will feature an onsite tour of the Water Resources Facility at the Palo Verde Generating Station.

The Renaissance Phoenix Glendale Hotel & Conference Center is steps away from restaurants, nightlife and shopping.

Registration Information -

The conference registration fee of \$650 includes breakfast for all three days, lunch on Wednesday and Thursday; a reception on Wednesday evening; and breaks associated with the conference. Not included in the registration fee is the \$50 cost associated with the optional pre-conference tour. Dress Code -

Conference: Business Casual

Pre-Conference Tour: You will be touring an industrial facility where safety is our number one priority, so please dress appropriately. The minimum required attire for your visit includes:

Directions from Phoenix Sky Harbor Airport (20 mi):

Driving Directions (20-30 minutes depending on traffic)

1. Start at Phoenix Sky Harbor Airport
 - o Head west on Sky Harbor Blvd toward I-10.
2. Merge onto I-10 West
 - o Follow signs for I-10 W toward Los Angeles.
3. Take Exit 139 for AZ-101 Loop North
 - o Merge onto Loop 101 North (Agua Fria Freeway).
4. Continue on Loop 101 North
 - o Drive for about 8 miles.
5. Take Exit 7 for Glendale Avenue
 - o Turn left (west) onto Glendale Avenue.
6. Turn right onto 95th Avenue
 - o Continue north until you reach Entertainment Boulevard.
7. Arrive at 9495 Entertainment Boulevard
 - o This is near Westgate Entertainment District and State Farm Stadium.
